THE SIAYA COUNTY FINANCE DRAFT BILL, 2024

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Siaya to provide for revenue raising measures, imposition of fees and charges for the County Government of Siaya and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Siaya as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

1. This Act may be cited as the Siaya County Finance Bill, 2023 and shall come into operation upon assent by His Excellency the Governor and Publication in the Kenya Gazette.

Short title and Commencement

2. This Act prescribes the rates of taxes and charges for the assessment year 2022-2023, the rates at which taxes and other charges will be payable during the financial year 2023-2024 from properties which include land and buildings, businesses, markets, agricultural produce, outdoor advertisement, health services, vehicle parking, heritage sites, County parks, entertainment and extraction activities.

Object and Purpose of Act

3. Interpretation: -

In this Act, except where the context otherwise requires –

Interpretation

“Cess” means tax or fees chargeable on certain goods specified under various schedule in this Act and shall include a special levy on value added products to promote the growth of the industry, factories and shall include but is not limited to factory cee, mining cess and sand cess;

“Authorized Channel” means any channel legally permitted by the County Government of Siaya in its dealings and service provisions

“County Revenue Collector” means the county public officer appointed pursuant to section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act,2012 for the purpose of collecting revenue for the County Government and remitting it to the County Receiver of Revenue

“County Government” means the County Government of Siaya

“County Receiver of Revenue”; in relation to the county government, means a person designated to be a receiver of revenue under section 157 of the PFM Act 2012;

“County Executive Committee Member”; means the member of a County Executive Committee responsible for the financial affairs of the County and for the County Treasury.

“Contributions in lieu of rates (CILOR)” means a charge payable by National Government Agencies to County Government of Siaya for spaces they occupy;

“Revenue Director” means overall officer in charge of a revenue directorate in the County

“Municipality Revenue Officer” means officer in charge of revenue mobilization and collection within any Municipality within the County

“Sub-County Revenue Officer” means officer in charge of revenue mobilization; collection and management at any subcounty within the County.

“Administrative ward” shall denote areas represented by Member of County Assembly.

“Jua-Kali” Shall refer to traders Registered with Kenya chamber of commerce and industries or Kenya Industrial Estates (K.I.E) within the county.

“Trade License”. The words “Single Business Permit” as previously applied by savings is replaced by the term “Trade License” as provided for by the Fourth Schedule, Part 7(b) of the Constitution.

For the year 2023/2024 Trade License fee in respect of businesses liable to be charged shall be as specified in PART I Schedules two, columns 1, 2 and 3 of this Act.

The Act further sets out other charges and reliefs which entail;

a) Penalties; Penalties shall be chargeable at 3% cumulative per month as the amount of additional fee payable for non-payment or late payment for any grant or renewal thereof.

b) Marginal Relief Provision of marginal relief for businesses that clear the amount by the turn of year to ensure that annual amount of Trade License payable does not accrue penalties until after 31st of March in each calendar year.

“Business Code” means unique code issued to every class of source of revenue stream for the purpose of revenue collection.

“Tax” shall refer to a compulsory financial contribution imposed by the County Government of Siaya within its jurisdiction.

“Entry Fee” shall refer to levies charged on cess from other counties on transit through Siaya County

4. “Bed Occupancy Charges” In respect of bed occupancy under Legal Gazette Notice 157 and devolved function of domestic tourism, the rates of fees and charges on registered rooms for class C and D hotel under the Trade License are as provided in the Third Schedule to the Act

5. That in order to have a smooth, transparent and equitable levy system for purposes of Schedule 3 the following meanings have been assigned to the following terms, where not specified;

- a) “Kiosk” a temporary structure occupying space equal to or less than 5M2
- b) “Small trader/ dealer” a business person occupying space equal to or less than 25 M2
- c) “Medium trader” a business person occupying over 25M2 up to 60M2
- d) “Large trader” a business person occupying between 60M2 and 225 M2
- e) “Wholesaler” a business person occupying between 225 and 450 M2
- f) “Mega” a business person occupying between 450M2 and 600 M2
- g) “Hypermarkets” a business person occupying between 600 M2 and 750 M2
- h) “Mega Hypermarkets” a business occupying between 750 M2 and 900 M2
- i) “Small School – 1 - 50 students/Pupils.
- j) “Medium School – 51 - 150 students/Pupils.
- k) “Large School– 151 - 200 students/Pupils.
- l) “Extra Large Schools – above 200 students/Pupils.
- m) “The term ‘school’ shall refer to and include Early Childhood Development Education Centers, pre-primary, primary, secondary and driving schools.
- n) “The term “Higher learning institutions” shall refer to and include colleges, technical institutes and universities.

6. (a) That the County shall seek to seal all loopholes that promote corruption, tax evasion and loss of revenue.

(b) There shall be a deliberate move to bring on board all stake- holders in discussing and getting involved in drafting this document for purposes of getting the harmonized licenses and levies in accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of Kenya 2010.

(c) The County shall be at liberty to make such regulations as may be expedient for proper, prudent and frugal management and in accordance with the constitution of the Republic of Kenya 2010.

PART III - LEVIES, FEES AND CHARGES

7. Revenue sources

- a) All fees and charges related to the Department of Lands, Physical Planning, Housing and Urban Development under **SCHEDULE ONE**. These include land rates, plot rent, land sub-divisions, Cilor, wayleaves property rates, development control fees, advertisements, penalties, etc.
- b) All fees and charges related to the Department of Public Works, Energy, Roads and Transport under **SCHEDULE TWO**. These include Bus Park/Matatu/ Motorbike charges, parking charges, hire of plant and machinery charges, rent for houses, stalls, kiosks, associated penalties, Fire Inspection and Fire Engine Services etc.
- c) All fees, charges and licenses related to the Department of Enterprise, Trade, Industrial and Cooperative Development under **SCHEDULE THREE**. These include single business permit, market dues, liquor license, weights and measures, etc.

- d) All fees and charges related to the Department of Agriculture, Food and Livestock under **SCHEDULE FOUR**. These include market levy for stocks, public veterinary fees, slaughter fees, highland skin levies, farm produce cess, disease control fees, etc.
- e) All fees and charges related to the Department of Environment, Water, Irrigation and Natural Resources under **SCHEDULE FIVE**. These include environmental levies (cess) and permits, solid waste management, noise pollution permits, penalties, etc.
- f) All fees and charges related to the Department of Public Health Services and Sanitation under **SCHEDULE SIX**. These include building plan certificates, Occupation certificate, food hygiene license, inspection fees, associated penalties, Certificate of Medical Examination etc.
- g) All fees and charges related to the Department of Education, Youth Affairs Gender and Social Services under **SCHEDULE SEVEN**. These include hire of Siaya Stadium and other stadia, hire of social/culture halls, peoples' park, etc.
- h) Department of Governance, Administration and Information Technology Administration under **SCHEDULE EIGHT**. These include registration and inspection fees for private learning institutions and day cares, etc.

PART IV - ACCOUNTABILITY AND TRANSPARENCY

- i The Executive Member for Finance shall assign targets on revenue collections on the Sub-Counties and Siaya Municipality, Bondo Municipality and Ugunja Municipality.
- ii There shall be proper documentation of all cash collected as revenue on behalf of the County by the Revenue Officers and there shall be put in place cash registers
- iii It shall constitute an offence for any Revenue Officer to divert, or incur financial loss due to dishonesty, incompetence or malpractice for money received as revenue from the public for the County Government.
- iv To protect its revenue bases, the Executive Committee Member for Finance shall take up the existing Revenue collection centers already in the sub-counties and Siaya Municipality, Bondo Municipality and Bondo Municipality with such modifications as may be deemed necessary.
- v All persons deployed as Revenue Inspectors, Revenue Officers and Revenue Accountants shall be vetted for competence based on experience, skills, integrity, suitability and relevant training for deployment annually from the date of commencement of this Act.
- vi All Revenue Officers shall be responsible to the Executive Member for Finance.
- vii All debts owed to the defunct local authorities shall be recovered by and paid to the County Government.
- viii The Revenue Officer/and Revenue collector shall be held liable for any loss, stolen or unauthorized spending of revenue or and such money held by the officer.

ix Any person found culpable of such act (8 above) shall be dealt with in accordance with penal code and any other written laws.

x The Departments have a responsibility to:

- a) Identify revenue streams for purposes of increasing the tax base;
- b) Come up with rules and regulations to support revenue collection;
- c) Ensure that services incidental to revenue collection have been rendered

8. That the revenue raising measures of the County Government provided for in this Bill shall comply with Article 209(5) of the constitution and do not in any way prejudice National Economic Policies, economic activities across county boundaries or the National mobility of goods, services, capital or Labour;

i If any National Bill mentioned in Schedule 3 has not been amended to provide for the imposition of fees or charges for services by the county government, then item 7 of the Sixth schedule of the Constitution, applies in Siaya relation to the Bill.

ii To avoid doubt, nothing in this Bill is taken to prevent the county government from entering into a contract or agreement or other arrangement to provide service upon payment of a fee or charge.

iii In computation of time, reference to hour, day, month, year shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Procedure Act Cap 21 Laws of Kenya and Article 259 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010.

iv Revenue collection is entrenched in this Act as a 24 hour, seven days a week activity throughout the County.

9. Section 24 Cap 2 General Provision Laws of Kenya applies as follows:

Where an Act or part of an Act is repealed, subsidiary Legislation issued under or made in virtue thereof shall, unless a contrary intention appears, remain in force, so far as it is not inconsistent with the repealing Act, until it has been revoked or repealed by subsidiary Legislation issued or made under the provisions of the repealing Act, and shall be deemed for all purposes to have been made thereunder.

PART V - FEES AND CHARGES ON IMPOUNDED ITEMS, GOODS, ETC.

1. The county government shall impound goods, property or animals of a person,

(a) who has failed to pay revenue when it falls due; or

(b) whose goods, property or animals are found in undesignated, unlicensed or restricted area.

2. Impounding and storage charges shall be imposed on impounded buildings, items, animals, goods including carriers or any other property as prescribed in the First Schedule, Provided that a decision on not to pay impounding or storage charges where reasonable grounds exist shall be made by the county receiver of revenue.

3. Impounded items, goods including carriers or any other property shall be claimed within seven days failing which they shall be condemned and disposed off by the impounding authority in a manner prescribed by the Disposal of Uncollected Goods Act, 1988, and Government Public

Procurement and disposal Act 2015 without any further reference to the owner.

4. The county government shall upon making an application to a court with relevant jurisdiction, impound a building for the recovery of revenue owed for rates, rent and any other related charges by taking over its administration and management .
5. The impounding authority shall keep an inventory of the impounded goods, property or animals and their condition or status at the time of impounding and a copy thereof deposited with officer in charge of the pound yard.
6. The county government shall not bear any cost, loss, loss of user or damage to the impounded goods, property or animals, after expiry of the specified time as stipulated in the Siaya County Finance Act, 2020.

PART VI - RATES APPLICABLE, TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES – PAYABLE

10. The Rates, Taxes, Fees and Charges set out in the “New Charges” column of the schedule shall apply for the respective items listed in the “Item Description” column at the rate set out therein.

Charges

11. (1) All directions, resolutions, orders, authorizations and provisions that are Contained in the Siaya County Revenue Administration Act, 2014, Single Business Permits Regulations, Siaya County Trade License Act, 2014 & Public Finance Management Act, 2015(Revised) and other related laws and subsidiary legislations that are concerned with the revenue administration in the county shall be deemed to be part of this Bill.

Licenses, Permit and Permit Fees

(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to the specific respective amounts payable in respect of the rates, taxes, fees, charges or other levies and, in that regard, the amount provided shall be applicable as provided for in the “New Charges” columns in the Schedule.

PART VII - LICENCE FEES FOR GENERAL TRADER, SHOP, RETAIL SERVICES, ETC.

12. The county government shall impose a business trade license fees to a person who carries out the business of general trader, retail services, shop, financial services, insurance services or any other business as prescribed in the Third Schedule on calendar year basis.

13. (1) A person shall not carry out any business or service within the County without a valid license or permit issued by the relevant County Office.

General Fees

(2) A person who intends to carry out any of the businesses listed in the or under the schedule of the single business permit regulation shall apply for a license or permit from the relevant County offices or such other designated agents as shall be prescribed by the County Government from time to time.

(3) A person who applies for license under subsection (2) shall be issued with a license on the payment of the applicable fee, depending on the location and size of the business as specified in the schedule or the single business permit regulation.

(4) Licenses and permits issued under subsection (3) must be visibly displayed in its original form at the business premise at all times. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence.

Plot and House
Rent

14. (1) A person occupying any plot, stall or house leased or rented out by the County Government shall pay rent or rates, whichever is applicable, at the rate specified in the Schedule.

(2) A penalty of three percent per month shall be charged for any amount of rent or rates for a plot that remains unpaid for after the 31st day of March Yearly.

(3) A person who contravenes the provisions of subsection (1) may be evicted in accordance with existing legislations on evictions if he or she fails to pay house rent for three consecutive months.

(4) The County Government shall repossess the Plot, stall or house if a person fails to pay the rent or rates, whichever is applicable for more than one year.

15. (1) Cess / market fee shall be charged on the goods specified in Schedule 3.

(2) There shall be established a levy on Murram, Hardcore, and Royalties to be effected at source. This Levy shall be paid by the Transporter.

(3) A person who fails to pay, evades a barrier, Check point or hinders an authorized person from Collecting cess or market fee set under this schedule commits an offence.

16. (1) All persons operating single business permits shall be required to pay the relevant licenses, fees and charges set under Schedule 2 and the single business permit Regulations.

Payments to the County

(2) Any person operating a business who fails to pay the said fees, charges or license set under Schedule 2 and the single business permit regulations commits an offence.

(3) Business permits shall not be issued for businesses being carried out in a building where land and ground rent are owing.

(4) A permit fee shall be paid to the County which may be revised from time to time.

(5) A permit maybe transferred by the holder to any person with prior consent of the county, accompanied by a fee which is subjected to revision from time to time.

PART VIII - POWER OF ENTRY AND INSPECTION

17. (1) An authorized officer shall, at all reasonable times and upon production of a valid identification card to the business owner or his or her agent to the person so requesting—

(a) enter land or buildings where such business is being carried out; and

(b) make such inspection and enquiries as may be necessary for ascertaining whether the provisions of this Act or the terms and conditions of the respective license are being complied with.

PART IX- POWER TO ENTER AND REMOVE

18. An authorized officer on behalf of the county receiver of revenue, shall have power to enter any place or premises and remove any material, structure, animal or object whose presence contravenes the requirements of this Act.

19. Every applicant for a single business permit shall produce the Previous years for proof of payment and rates of the county where applicable;

a) Every business shall pay an annual fee of Kshs 1000 for Municipalities and Town areas, Kshs 500 for Urban Centers and other unclassified market centers for Trade Name and a uniform Single Business Permit renewal fee of Kshs 300 across the County.

b) Single Business Permit issued expires on 31st December of every year.

c) Failure to apply and obtain a Single Business Permit by the 31st March of each year, the fees chargeable shall attract a penalty of 3 % of the SBP amount per month accumulatively.

d) That failure by a factory to remit cess as required within the stipulated period, the unpaid cess shall attract a penalty of 5% on the total cess withheld quarterly.

e) That the harvesting of sand, hard-core, murram and other royalties shall only be permitted after taking into consideration all relevant approval on environmental and public safety concerns from relevant bodies.

f) That it shall be an offence to excavate, dig and or mine any of the products named in (e) above without due regard to environmental and public safety concerns.

g) That it shall be the responsibility of the client to ensure that correct receipts/permits/licenses have been issued.

h) If any permit contravenes any of the conditions set out by County, the County may refuse to grant or renew it.

i) All business premises shall be required to be painted prior to issuance of single business permits; failure shall result in a fine being levied.

PART X - FEES FOR PRESCRIBED SERVICES

20. The county government shall charge fees prescribed in the Fifth Schedule for any person seeking any of the following services —

- (a) solid waste management;
- (b) environmental assessment;
- (c) physical planning services;
- (d) valuation and property management;
- (e) estate development;
- (f) firefighting;
- (g) engineering;
- (h) quantity survey;
- (i) land survey; and
- (j) library services.

PART XI - FEES FOR OUTDOOR ADVERTISING

21. (1) The county government shall charge the fees prescribed in the First Schedule to any person who erects or displays an outdoor advertisement or signage in the county.

(2) A person seeking to erect or display an outdoor advertisement or signage in the county shall first seek and obtain approval from the office responsible for developmental control.

(3) It shall be the responsibility of the advertiser to remove the advertisement or signage upon expiry of the advertisement period failing which the county receiver of revenue shall —

(a) Demand for payment for the advertisement or signage; or

(b) Remove or deface the advertisement or signage at the owner's cost.

(4) Upon expiry of the advertisement period the advertiser shall inform the county receiver of revenue.

(5) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence and shall be liable upon conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty thousand shillings or imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months in default thereof and shall in addition bear the cost of removing the advertisement or signage.

22. Where any matter or act done /omitted to be done by an officer when lawfully and in good faith executing any of the duties required to be done by him/her by an act or regulation, Rules or by-laws made there under or by any direction of the county subjects such an officer to any personal liability or action whatsoever, the county shall arrange for such an officer's legal defense in any proceedings that may be taken against him/her.

Indemnity

PART XII — OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

23. Any person who commits an offence under this Bill for which no penalty is provided shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings Two hundred thousand (200,000) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

General Penalty

24. A member of staff of the County Government having a duty to perform under this Bill who—

Offences by staff

(a) Makes, in any record, or document required to be kept or made by that person, an entry which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;

(b) Willfully refuses to do anything which he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe not to be true or to be false;

(c) Interferes with any other person or process under this Bill, so as to defeat the provisions, requirements or purposes of this Bill;

(d) Where required under this Bill to do anything to give effect to the provisions of this Bill, fails to do such thing;

(e) Without reasonable cause omits to do something in breach of his or her duty under this Bill;

- (f) Willfully contravenes the provisions of this Bill to give undue advantage / favor to another person;
- (g) Fails to prevent or report to the County or any other relevant authority, the commission of an offence committed under this Bill; Commits an offence and is liable on conviction, to a fine not exceeding Kenya Shillings two hundred thousand (200,000) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.
- (h) Staffs who operate businesses but fail to pay for their Taxes Due shall be subjected to a penalty of Five times the normal payment rate recoverable from their payrolls.

25. (i) All Passenger Service Vehicles (P.S.V) To and From Kisumu shall access the Bus park using Nyadorera-Kisumu Highway, those To and from Ugunja to branch off at Kenya Medical Training College (K.M.T.C via Stadium road. All PSV's are Prohibited from the Town Centre and shall not be allowed to use the Roads in front of the County Headquarters, County Assembly, The Law Courts, Commercial Bank, Co-Op. Bank and Huduma Centre. Any person who Contravenes this Actl commits an offence and shall be liable to payment of (Kshs 50,000) Fifty Thousands Shillings) fine or imprisonment for one year or both.

(ii) Buses and Shuttles' that have offices within the CBD shall access their offices to and from Kisumu by turning off at Shell filling station and join central primary School Road, Turn on Hospital Road past Kenya Medical Training College (KMTC) onto A.C.K Cathedral Stretch, Turn Right onto the Road Leading to Kenya Commercial Bank and proceed to their respective offices.

26. No Minibus when carrying passengers for hire or reward shall without the express authority of the Director of revenue or Enforcement Inspectorate, start or terminate at any place other than the Minibus Park. No person shall drop or pick passengers within a radius of 300 Meters within the Town apart from the designated areas. Any contravention of this law shall be liable to payment of a fine of Kenya Shillings Four Thousands(4,000),or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both

27. No person shall Hoot, Bang the Minibus body, make Noise, disturb piece in any manner or Tout in any form while in the vicinity of the County and Sub-County Headquarters, Assembly, The Law Courts and Hospitals, any contravention of this law shall be liable to payment of a fine of Kshs 10,000 (Ten Thousand), or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

28. i) Any motor vehicle that fails to pay park entry fee prescribed in the bus Park fees and charges shall have such vehicles Clamped and towed away a fine of Thirty Thousand Shillings (Kshs 30,000) shall be levied or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

ii) When any motor vehicle fails to pay entry fee and such vehicle is impounded and clamped the owner shall be expected to pay Kenya Shillings Five Thousand and Fifty (5,050) and clamping fee of Kenya Shillings of Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500)

iii) Independent Towing trucks operating within the jurisdiction of the County Government area must be licensed by the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) and County Government single business permit for transport.

iv) When an impounded vehicle is being towed County enforcement officers shall be expected to be present in full uniform and their name tags conspicuously displayed at all times during the operation.

29. Any vehicle /Motor Cycle/ Bicycle riding or Parking on Non- motorized walkways shall be Clamped/impounded, a fine of Fifteen Thousand Kshs (15,000) shall be Levied on Motor Vehicles, Motor Cycles Two Five Thousand (Kshs 2,500) and One Thousand (Kshs 1,000) Bicycles respectively for such an offence or imprisonment for a term not exceeding Six months or both.

30. Any individual whose Motor Vehicle is Clamped and such an individual proceeds to remove a Clamp without the Authority of an Authorized officer shall be deemed to have Committed an offence, and shall be fined Thirty Thousand Shillings (30,000) or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding Three years or both.

31. Any individual or institution that Dumps refuse in an undesignated place shall be liable to a fine of Fifty Thousand Shillings(50,000), or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or both.

32. Any individual who shall be found to have damaged any property in the Bus Park, Governors park, Ahindi Garden or any other County property for that matter, shall have Committed an offence and shall pay a fine of at least Five Thousand Shillings (Kshs 5,000) for repair of such damages.

33. No individual, Organization/Group shall without the Rightful Authority of the County Directors of Enforcement and Revenue Block a public Road for any Sporting activity, without payment of the requisite fee.

(i) Persons living with disability (PWD's) liable to County taxes, licenses, fees and charges may apply to the C. E. C. M responsible for Finance for exemption, of a $\frac{1}{3}$ of all levies, except rates.

(ii) The County Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance shall, in consultation with the Department, assess all applications received under Sub Section (1) and make such order thereon, if any, as he deems fit, exempting the applicant wholly, or to the extent provided by the order, from County Taxes, licenses, fees and Charges specified therein, and any such order shall, notwithstanding the provisions of any other Act, have effect according to its terms. This Section shall not apply to controlled Liquor licenses and any other licenses dealing in a controlled business thereof.

34. All Sub-County Offices/Compounds will be Gazetted Impounding areas

35. Any individual or institution that shall be deemed to have obstructed County officers from carrying out their duties, will have committed an offence and shall be liable to a fine of Kenya Shillings Three Hundred Thousand (300,000) or imprisonment to a period not exceeding Twenty-Four Months (24 Months) imprisonment or both

36. The Directorate of Revenue, County Enforcement and Municipal Managers/Sub-County Administrators shall amongst themselves co-ordinate and authorize setting up of designated boda boda stages. Contravention of this regulation by any Boda Boda Group to set up any un-authorized stage, will attract a fine of Kenya Shillings Fifty Thousand (Kshs 50,000) or a term of Two years imprisonment or both.

37. Any individual or Firm that shall leave a quarry site without restoration to original form shall be liable to a fine of Kenya Shillings Two Hundred Thousand (200,000) or Imprisonment for a period of one year or both.

38. Any person found pulling or pushing any materials in a manner likely to cause damage to road or any road furniture shall have committed an offence and be liable to a fine of Kenya Shillings One Thousand (Kshs 1,000) or imprisonment to a term of six months or both.

39. All liquified petroleum gas (L.P.G) traders shall be required to display gas cylinders in cages for safety purposes, failure shall attract a fine of Kenya shillings Ten thousand fine (10,000) or imprisonment to a term not exceeding six months or both.

40. Any person or licensee who gives false information or makes false statement either orally or in writing in connection with a call of information made under this Act or in connection with an investigation into the commission of an offence under this Act, or abates the commission of the offence contemplated herein above commits an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine or jail term for a term not exceeding three (3) years or to both as contemplated under the penalty section as per section 23 above.

PART XIII — MISCELLANEOUS

41. (1) Any charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees payable to the County Government at the commencement of this Bill by any business operating within the county which are not included in any of the Schedules to this Bill, shall continue to be chargeable by, and payable to the County Government unless they are repealed by a Bill of the County Government or until a Bill of the County Government on such charges, permit fees, license fees, rent, cess and such other fees is enacted.

(2) All businesses within the jurisdiction of the County shall be required to pay licenses, charges, fees, cess, rent or other prescribed fees unless specifically exempted by any relevant legislation or authority.

(3) Unless otherwise provided in this Bill, the rates for fees, charges, licenses, cess or rent, applicable before the commencement of this Bill in respect of any business, activity, goods or services listed in the schedules, shall cease to apply.

PART XIV – AMENDMENT TO THE SCHEDULES

42. This section adopts the provisions of the transition clauses in sixth Schedule of the Constitution sections 6 and 33 as regards existing laws and institutions that were in force immediately before the Counties as relates to the various taxes, licenses and other charges or fees to be construed to continue being in force for the purposes of this Act; and the taxes, licenses and other charges chargeable under this Act by virtue of the said legislations shall automatically transition and

be deemed to be charges under the various relevant County legislations as shall from time to time be enacted by the County Assembly (under currently saved).

43. (1) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance may by order published in the gazette amend any additional fees, tax, license, cess and fees schedules to supplement the current schedule.

(2) Any order made under subsection (1) shall be laid before the County Assembly without unreasonable delay, and unless a resolution approving the order is passed by the County Assembly within Twenty-one days when the Assembly next sits after the order is so laid, the order shall lapse, but without prejudice to anything previously done there under.

PART XV - TAX INCENTIVES AND RELIEFS .

44. Executive Committee Member may pursuant to article 210 of the Constitution and Section 159 of the PFM Act issue tax relief, waiver and incentives in consultation with respective County Department Executive Committee Members with respect to revenue management as provided in Section 63(1) of the Financial Regulation, 2014.
